

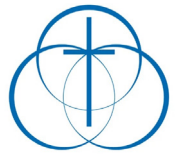

Day 1 – 13 May, Monday

FLIGHT TO MALTA

Depart the U.S. to Malta International Airport.

Day 2 – 14 May, Tuesday

MALTA ARRIVAL

On arrival:

The Grand Harbour -

A private Cruise sailing in a traditional “dghajsa” and a splendid relaxing way to appreciate Valetta’s fine buildings and skyline.

Dinner & Overnight in VALLETTA

Day 3 – 15th May, Wednesday

PAUL'S MALTA

St. Paul's Bay -

To the north of the Island and stop where the ‘two seas meet’ and location of Paul’s shipwreck.

Mdina-Rabat -

A visit to the CATHEDRAL OF MDINA (known as the silent city). Then to St. PAUL'S CHURCH and grotto.

Dinner & Overnight in VALLETTA

Day 4 – 16th May, Thursday

GOZO ISLAND

A short ferry sail then visits to:

The Temples of Ġgantija/ a megalithic temple complex older than the pyramids.

The Citadel/ built on the site of an early Stone Age settlement. **The Cathedral/** Baroque style and dedicated to Mary, mother of Jesus.

Dinner & Overnight in VALLETTA

Day 5 – 17th May, Friday

MALTA to SICILY

The ‘Malta Experience’ – 7,000 years of Maltese history. To the airport for the short 45 minute flight from Malta to CATANIA in Sicily -

Day 6 – 18th May, Saturday

St. PAUL'S SICILY

Syracuse Archaeological Site/Roman Amphitheatre/

Greek Theatre/Temple of Apollo/ “Dionysus’ Ear”/

(very similar to the “Siq” at Petra).

St. PAUL'S SICILY

Syracuse Old Town –

A guided walking tour of the little Ortigia island (the heart of the town)

Free time for leisure to explore the Old Town area.

Dinner and Overnight in SYRACUSE

Day 8 – 20th May, Monday

SICILY

Mount Etna/ see the volcano - the highest an active in Europe. **Taormina/** time to browse in the quaint hillside town.

Dinner and Overnight in SYRACUSE

Day 9 – 21st May, Tuesday

SICILY/AGRIGENTO

A day trip to the ‘Valley of the Temples’ and this major impressive site in central Sicily - a UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE. Dinner in Palermo then fly to Naples.

Overnight in POZZUOLI

Day 10 – 22nd May, Wednesday

PAUL'S ROME

The Appian Way/ a walk on a preserved section.

The Colosseum/ the huge structure of Imperial Rome.

The Forum/ Rome’s main ancient market place. **The Underground Church/** a 4th-century basilica converted out of the home of a Roman nobleman.

The Mamertine Prison/ associated with the crucifixion of Peter.

Dinner & Overnight in ROME.

Day 11 - 23rd May, Thursday

ROME

THE MORNING

The Vatican/ a ‘City State’ encompassed by a retaining wall containing the famous Sistine Chapel and St. Peters’ Basilica. **Basilica of St. Paul/** founded by the Constantine over the burial place of Saul of Tarsus.

THE AFTERNOON

Free to visit places of personal interest.

Dinner & Overnight in ROME

Day 12 – 24th May, Friday

RETURN FLIGHT

To Rome airport for the return flight to the U.S.
